Pale gold in colour, the wine offers great aromatic purity, laced with citrus, white blossom, lemon zest and mossy notes. On the palate, generous orchard fruit is laced with hints of brioche, a combination that has become Delamotte's hallmark. The mousse is fine, delicate and light.</i> | 70 |

| 4 | Champagne R de Ruinart NV Brut <i>Beautifully balanced with a fine acidity to counteract the delicate brioche and citic fruit.</i> | 85 |
| 5 | Champagne Pol Roger 2009 <i>An explosive yet focused nose of ripe stone fruits and brioche notes. It has a poised and elegant palate packed with green apple, autolytic notes and a crisp, steely acidity. There is an incredible balance to this Champagne which displays all the hallmarks of a vintage built for the long term. It has a powerful structure and a long, evolving, complex finish.</i> | 135 |

| 28 | Mâcon Solutré 2017, Francois Auvigne, Burgundy <i>Pale-medium lemon in colour. The nose is surprisingly full showing ripe stone fruit, mixed with almond and marzipan. The palate is elegant and has a characteristic freshness which is balanced by orchard fruit.</i> | 37 |
| 31 | Côtes-du-Rhône Blanc Guy Louis 2016, Tardieu-Laurent, Rhône <i>Shimmering gold and captivating, with floral notes, stone fruit and vanilla cream to the fore, with hints of warm brioche, macadamia nuts and pain aux raisins. The palate adds honey and fennel notes to apricot compote, refreshed by citrus and underscored by minerals.</i> | 39 |
| 33 | Gewürztraminer 2015, Emile Beyer, Alsace <i>Classic Alsace Gewürztraminer, with with honeyed lychee fruit and gentle spice aromas following through to a dry finish.</i> | 45 |
| 34 | Sancerre Domaine de la Grande Maison 2018, Chameau Balland, Loire <i>The nose is mineral, saline, with hints of stone fruit (peaches), white blossoms and a pleasant creaminess. | 35 | Bourgogne Blanc Les Setilles 2016, Olivier Leflaive, Burgundy <i>Bright lemon in colour. The nose is pretty and fresh with notes of white flower. The palate shows citrus and apple notes, balanced with hints of creamy vanilla. The finish is long and lifted - a stunning wine from this superb producer.</i> | 47 |
| 37 | Pouilly-Fumé Les Chaumiennes 2017, A&E Figeat, Loire <i>With smoky greengage, grapefruit and nettle on the nose combined with zesty lime, yellow plum and elderflower on the palate, this wine is multi-layered and exceptionally elegant.</i> | 55 |
| 38 | Montagny 1er Cru Bonneveaux 2017, Olivier Leflaive, Burgundy <i>Bright lemon in colour with flashes of green. Fresh stone fruits with hints of ginger on the nose. The wine has a great minerality balanced with plenty of concentrated, creamy fruit on the palate.</i> | 65 |
| 40 | Bourgogne Blanc 2016, Domaine Leflaive <i>From what is considered to be the greatest producer in Burgundy and probably by extension arguably the world's finest white producer, this is no ordinary Bourgogne Blanc, being declassified Puligny Montrachet from a couple of specific plots. The great 2016 vintage is drinking superbly now.</i> | 80 |
| 41 | Meursault Les Clousots Domaine Patrick Javillier 2015 <i>Pale yellow-gold, this presents a very pretty, gentle nose of warm brioche, nuts, delicate caramel and vanilla cream - a pastry shop attraction. The palate is similarly evocative, with equally appetising aromatics, though a fresh redeeming acidity avoids it being too hedonistic, with a very lovely finish. which drives through to a prolonged, layered and very lovely finish.</i> | 95 |
| 42 | Puligny-Montrachet 2016, Domaine Francois Carillon <i>Pale, shimmering gold, this is a delight. Lemon and apple pastries combine with delicate apricot notes, white flowers and crushed shell minerals on both the nose and palate, super - fresh and focused, with an attractive acidity, giving balance and direction - a lovely wine, beautifully handled.</i> | 97 |
| 43 | Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru Chenevottes 2015, Domaine Francois Carillon <i>Beautifully floral, with delicate notes of apple blossom, gentle lime notes and an underlying minerality. Juicy and amply fruited, with very primary, welcoming white stone-fruit, offset by a nice bite of dried-stone minerality.</i> | 125 |

ITALIAN WHITES

- 30 **Chardonnay Grand Cru 2016, Rapitali, Sicily** 39
Wonderful Chardonnay from the exciting new Old World of Sicily. Warm, soft and smooth tropical fruits with firm vanilla oak notes.
- 25 **Pinot Grigio, L'Aristocratico 2017, Trentino, Italy** 28
A fine example of this popular grape sourced from high altitude vineyards in the foothills of the Alps. The long ripening season creates a flavourful and expressive wine with zesty fruit and long lingering finish.

GERMAN WHITES

- 27 **Rheingau Riesling Kabinett Fruchtsuss 2018, Schloss Schonborn, Germany** 35
This is rich and graceful, combining floral notes with green apples, lemon and ripe grape compote underscored by crushed slate minerals- focused, with fine acidity.

AUSTRALIAN WHITES

- 29 **Pinot Gris 2018, Bay of Fires, Tasmania** 38
Lively, enticing aromas of pear and rosewater, the off dry palate features characters of melon and peach.
- 32 **St Hallett Riesling 2017, Eden Valley, Australia** 42
Shows aromas of flint and spice intermingles with lemon blossom and lime peel. The palate is vibrant with citrus and mineral notes.

USA WHITES

- 39 **Chardonnay 2016, Cakebread Cellars, Napa Valley, California** 79
Bright gold in colour. The nose is full of creamy tropical fruit and shortbread, with subtle hints of toffee and fudge. The palate is weighty and textured but balanced with fresh minerality and a long, silky finish.

SOUTH AFRICAN WHITES

- 23 **Nederburg 'The Anchorman' Chenin Blanc 2017, Western Cape, South Africa** 38
Named after the founder of Nederburg, Philppus Wolvaart, who first planted Chenin Blanc in the late 18th century. Dry, mineral and well-structured, it shows ripe apricot, orange with hints of raisin, spice and floral notes.
- 36 **Chardonnay 2016, Nelson Estate, Paarl, South Africa** 50
Bright gold in colour, this is a weighty, rich and creamy Chardonnay, with subtle oak flavours. It is beautifully balanced with a graceful acidity and freshness. This is a good all-rounder which ages very well.

ARGENTINIAN REDS

- 83 **Malbec 2016, Bodega Ruca Malen, Mendoza, Argentina** 39
Vibrant, dark purple-red, with ripe, red cherries, plum fruit and notes of spicy liquorice. Full and well-structured on the palate, with elegant, soft tannins and ripe black fruit balanced by a spicy oak and a delicate, vanilla and chocolate finish. Delicious!
- 92 **Salentein Barrel Selection Malbec 2017, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina** 42
Full bodied and silky palate offers dark berry fruit backed by vanilla on the lasting finish. From one of the oldest producers in Argentina, the winery can trace its roots back to the 17th century.

CHILEAN REDS

- 81 Veramonte Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Colchagua Valley, Chile** **28**
From low-yielding vines, this wine is aged for 18 months in French and American oak barrels for richness and complexity. Ripe blackcurrants with a dash of spice. Very smooth and pronounced with a super balance.
- 86 Primus Carmenere 2016, Colchagua Valley, Chile** **35**
Richly flavoured, plum and blackberry fruit mingling with exotic spice and dried fig.

PORTUGUESE REDS

- 88 Quinta de Chocapalha Tinto 2015, Sandra de Tavares, Lisbon** **38**
Deep plum- ruby, with hints of violet, this has a heightened focus on the nose, cassis and floral notes, spiced. The palate is warming and supple with good depth and concentration, fruit compote supported by ripe, rounded tannins.

SOUTH AFRICAN REDS

- 89 Mourvedre Grenache Syrah Rhebokskloof Wine Estate Paarl 2015, SA** **39**
Vibrant juicy dark plum and black cherry fruit from the Grenache & Shiraz mingle with the soft strawberry and earthy minerality of Mourvèdre. A violet perfume is layered with white pepper, clove and sweet cinnamon spices.
- 94 Shiraz Nelson Estate 2012, Paarl, South Africa** **47**
Deep, dark, black-ruby core, fading slightly at the rim. Dark, ripe fruit on the nose with rich mocha notes. On the palate the fruit is concentrated and mature with great structure and a smoky/savoury finish. The trademark Nelson Estate elegance and freshness is still present.

ITALIAN REDS

- 87 Valpolicella Superiore Rocolo di Mizzole Cecilia Beretta 2016, Veneto** **36**
A delicious example from this single vineyard offering from the heart of Valpolicella. Deep ruby red, with fine bitter cherry fruit, soft and ripe with a nice bite of acidity on the end.
- 95 Primitivo del Manduria 2016, Gocce, Feudi Salentini, Italy** **48**
Wild berries and notes of caramel, smooth with some spicy aromatic notes.
- 100 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2014, Bolla** **60**
The traditional method of semi drying the grapes first ensures an enveloping velvet richness with mazipan, rasin and date flavours.
- 104 Barolo La Tartufaia 2013, Giulia Negri, Piedmont** **80**
This La Tartufaia is really attractive deep garnet in colour. It offers a mature nose, savoury notes allied to liqueur macerated dried fruit compote, perfumed and spicy. The palate is silken, mocha-rich, with earthy dark chocolate and espresso notes, layered with black cherry and cream- all underscored by mineral precision and refreshed by rose and violet.

NEW ZEALAND REDS

- 93 Pinot Noir 2017, Eradus Estate, Awatere Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand** **45**
Deep, dark ruby, with purple flashes. The nose has meaty, dark fruit and some farmyard notes. The palate has plenty of dark berry fruit and some savoury and earthy characters. This is all balanced with the trademark Eradus acidity and freshness - delicious.

SPANISH REDS

- 85 Rioja Reserva, Viña Real 2014, Rioja, Spain** 45
A blend of Tempranillo, Garnacha, Mazuelo and Graciano with gentle oak ageing. Gorgeously fragrant with soft fruit, warm spices and elegant toasty oak aromas.
- 99 Psi 2014, Peter Sisseck, Bodegas y Vinedos Alnardo, Ribera del Duero** 55
Produced by the great Peter Sisseck from the stellar Dominio de Pingus, this wine has ripe aromatic black fruit, plum and cherry compote aromas, complemented by mineral notes. Expansive and generous on the palate, richly textured and bursting with personality.

AUSTRALIAN REDS

- 102 19th Meeting Cabernet Sauvignon The Lane 2012, Adelaide Hills, Australia** 75
Deep, plummy red colour. The nose offers Cassis, tobacco leaf and mocha with a touch of mint. The palate is medium to full bodied, with rich, deep varietal flavours. Classic in structure, this wine is smooth and weighty with, fine, ripe tannins and impressive length.

USA REDS

- 106 Othello Cabernet Sauvignon 2012, Dominus Estate, Napa Valley, California** 90
Very pure, ripe black cherry and blackberries on the nose, then some menthol, with a little cedar and some graphite. So far, so Cabernet. The palate is medium-bodied on the entry, ingratiating itself over the course of a fine, elegant mid-palate, which reveals texture and a nicely nuanced structure. Fine earthy minerality and a detailed finish. Lifted acidity ensures juicy drinkability from Christian Moueix.
- 107 Two Creeks Pinot Noir 2015, Cakebread Cellars, Anderson Valley, California** 95
This Anderson Valley Pinot Noir displays an earthy, fresh cherry and raspberry aroma accentuated by hints of sandalwood and minerality. Medium-bodied and supple on the palate, with fine tannins, this wine is juicy with concentrated black cherry, red currant and black raspberry with a long, vibrant finish, bright acidity and a refreshing minerality.

FRENCH REDS

- 84 Pinot Noir, Bouchard Aîné & Fils 2016, Bourgogne** 39
From one of the oldest estates in Burgundy, this winery was founded in 1731 and offers wonderful family made wines. A nose redolent of red fruit and fruit-tree blossom: the palate has fine, smooth tannins and a refreshing finish.
- 90 Côte de Rhône Les Forots 2016, Jean-Luc Colombo** 40
A rare Cotes du Rhône that is only made from grapes from Northern Rhone and, as such is only produced from the Syrah grape. Harmonious with a fine structure and a good attack of ripe blackberries, raspberries and blueberries.
- 91 Château La Courolle 2016, St Émilion** 42
Plum ruby in colour, this has an inviting, accessible nose, rich in cherry and cassis, with delicate hints of vanilla. Fresh and upbeat, in line with the vintage, there is good fruit on the palate, nuances of dark chocolate and espresso coffee, all supported by firm, well-integrated tannins. A good food wine.
- 96 Moulin-a-Vent Coeur de Terroir Vieilles Vignes Domaine Labruyère 2015** 49
A saturated ruby colour, followed by a beautiful pure red berry nose, dense and inviting. The palate is veritably singing, so ripe and supple, with resounding raspberry fruit. Darts of dark ferrous minerality and a seam of brininess from the mid-palate through to the finish.

| 97 | Château de Lamarque 2015, Cru Bourgeois, Haut Médoc <i>This is fresh and sweet, with pure, aromatic fruit, black and red fruit to the fore, scented with violet. Fresh cherries and red fruit prevail on the palate, allied sherbet and white pepper spice. There is an earthy minerality giving focus and some weight and texture on the mid-palate which will continue to evolve during elevelage.</i> | 52 |
| 98 | Château Notton 2012, Margaux, Bordeaux <i>Ripe strawberry with blackcurrant and developing liquorice aromas. Ripe and supple in the mouth.</i> | 55 |
| 101 | Châteauneuf-du-Pape Grande Réserve 2014, Château Beauchêne <i>This is a wonderful example from this small, yet excellent estate. Rich, dark and handsome! This full-bodied and concentrated red exudes moreish flavours of baked plum and damson fruit, kirsch and sweet spice.</i> | 65 |
| 103 | Côte-Rotie Vieilles Vignes 2011, Tardieu-Laurent, Rhône <i>Shimmering jet-plum velvet in appearance, with a tight, firm pink rim, this has an extraordinary nose – a blend of fresh fruit, warm plum compote, crushed stone and briny minerals, wild herbs and heady violet freshness. The palate echoes the aromatics presented on the nose, complex, intricate and slightly reticent in the embryonic phase. Dark fruit, with a slightly savoury edge strikes an engaging, impressive balance.</i> | 80 |
| 105 | Château Fonroque 2009, Grand Cru Classe St Émilion <i>Aromas of sweet cherries, blackcurrant and sagebrush abound on the nose, while the medium to full bodied palate is unctuous, mature and ripe, with silky rich red and black fruits, going to an elegant, long finish.</i> | 80 |
| 108 | Gevrey Chambertin Cuvee Ostréa 2012, Domaine Trapet, Burgundy <i>Now drinking very nicely, this Gevrey from top producer, Jean Louis Trapet has great delineation and focus, with appreciable raspberry and cranberry fruit to the fore. Fresh and ripe with lovely touches of dark cherries, blood orange ad cassis fruit and a palpable nervosity.</i> | 95 |
| 109 | Volnay 1er Cru Frémiets 2012, Marquis D'Angerville, Burgundy <i>A very attractive bouquet of briary fruit, tea leaf and a touch of blackcurrant. Nicely dry, fined and fresh, this medium bodied Burgundy is in the heart of its drinking window, displaying a fine purity.</i> | 120 |
| 110 | Château Léoville Poyferré 2011, 2eme Cru St Julien, Bordeaux <i>A great success in the 2011 vintage, the Leoville Poyferre is broad, rich and medium to full bodied and dense. Concentrated silky tannins and a big rich mouthfeel. Excellent and a really fine St Julien.</i> | 125 |
| 111 | L'Espérance de Trotanoy 2010, Pomerol, Bordeaux <i>The second wine of the legendary Chateau Trotanoy and from the magnificent 2010 vintage. Black cherries and damp earth dominate the palate with hints of graphite and spice. Only 500 cases of this nectar produced.</i> | 125 |
| 112 | Château Brane Cantenac 2006, 2eme Cru Margaux, Bordeaux <i>Now nicely mature, this Brane Cantenac displays savoury red berry fruit, tertiary notes and sandalwood, which develops in the glass. Medium bodied with fine grainy tannins, nicely structured but still with plenty of freshness.</i> | 130 |
| 113 | Château Pontet Canet 2007, 5eme Cru Pauillac <i>Upfront and lavish with red and black fruits tinged with violets and crème de Cassis. The palate is sweet and opulent, displaying impressive concentration and velvety blueberry and black cherry on the finish that lingers long in the mouth.</i> | 145 |
| 114 | Château Léoville Barton 1988, 2eme Cru St Julien, Bordeaux <i>Leoville Barton's magnificent wines are well know for their longevity and the 1988 is now nicely into its stride. Classically structured with deep earthy Cassis and cranberry fruit intermixed with wood smoke, minerals, tobacco leaf an roasted herbs. Medium to full bodied with moderate tannins, giving a rich and elegant mouthfeel.</i> | 150 |
| 115 | Château Bélair Monange 2011, 1er Grand Cru Classé St Émilion, Bordeaux <i>This tiny jewel of an estate, situated next to Château Ausone and under the expert tutelage of the Moueix family, produces only about 1500 cases per year. Gorgeous aromas of kirsch, crushed rock, raspberry and subtle oak followed by a medium bodied concentrated mouthfeel.</i> | 165 |

- 116 Chambolle Musigny 2011, Comte Georges de Vogüé, Burgundy 195**
From probably the finest producer in Musigny, the 2011 Chambolle is drinking now, with its fragrant, voluminous bouquet of plush red cherries and a touch of Cassis. The palate is opulent and sweetly fruited on the entry, with fine tannins underpinning this classic wine.
- 117 Château Lynch Bages 2009, 5eme Cru Pauillac, Bordeaux 250**
Upfront and lavish with red and black fruits tinged with violets and crème de Cassis. The palate is sweet and opulent, displaying impressive concentration and velvety blueberry and black cherry on the finish that lingers long in the mouth.

GOLFER'S WINES

- 151 Sauvignon Blanc 2017, Stellenbosch, South Africa 39**
Bursting with fig, nettles and a melange of tropical fruit. A whist of passion fruit on the nose leads through to a rich palate and elegant core. Mineral, almost slate-like notes, add depth of complexity to this fruit-driven and yet sophisticated style. The mid-palate shows fine texture and finishes with a zing of green pepper and touch of melon. Already drinking well, this will be best over the next 2 years.
- 152 Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Stellenbosch, South Africa 59**
Pure-fruited Cassis on the nose open to a fine balance of dark chocolate, wet earth, delicate spice and dried herbs. The palate has a dark inky intensity punched by a core of mineral finesse and all wrapped by a broad-shouldered finish. The tannins are burly and taught, but will easily integrate with time as this decadent Cabernet Sauvignon will age well for a decade. Serious yet sumptuous.
- 153 Proprietor's Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Stellenbosch, South Africa 75**
Cabernet Sauvignon comes across with striking purity. It is once again richly concentrated and yet remarkably elegant and refined. Purple hued and powerfully built, its components are seamlessly knitted into a Cassis-fruited, superbly layered palate. Hints of black cherries, dark chocolate, graphite and apricots are all balanced by its subtle oak support. The immense purity of fruit fits like a jigsaw into the perfectly chiseled, tannic frame. Finally finishing with inviting freshness and lacy tannins, this wonderful wine will evolve for a decade or more.
- 154 Signature Bordeaux Blend 2013, Stellenbosch, South Africa 99**
Ernie Els Signature is similar to the empathic and precise 2009 although packs even more power and performance. Cabernet Sauvignon based, all five Bordeaux varieties contribute to its superior complexity, class and character. The black core with purple rim shows its huge concentration, with time needed in the glass to coerce its depth of flavours. Ripe mulberry, strawberries laced with balsamic, graphite and a hint of chocolate all follow through to the luxuriously textured palate. The rich fruit is balanced by a refined acidity and savoury, roasted-coriander-scented, meaty-edge.
