15	Brut Nature, Jurtschitsch, 2017, Kamptal, Austria <i>The project of Alwin and Stefanie, a winemaker's couple that run the family winery since 2010, farming the vineyards organically since when they started. Bright sparkling wines made with Grüner Veltliner the most popular grape in Austria. Green apple flavours on the nose and a very gastronomic palate!</i>	69

BURGUNDY

- 44 **Bourgogne Aligote, Joseph Drouhin, 2020** 45
A wine that is always fresh and aromatic. The colour is pale yellow, with green reflections. On the nose, aromas of fresh grape, slightly acidic. Fresh on the palate, sometimes with a pleasant "gunflint" note. Good balance between softness and acidity
- 28 **Mâcon Solutr -Pouilly, Francois Auvigne, 2022** 52
Pale-medium lemon in colour. The nose is surprisingly full showing ripe stone fruit, mixed with almond and marzipan. The palate is elegant and has a characteristic freshness which is balanced by orchard fruit.
- 49 **Mâcon Milly Lamartine, Les H ritiers du Comte Lafon, 2019** 52
A fresh, mineral cuv e from a notably cool vineyard, towards the top of an east-facing slope. It's characterised by zesty acidity, white fruit and a mouth-watering, subtly saline finish.
- 25 **Chablis, Domaine Vincent Dampt, 2022** 64
Vincent Dampt's signature wine is an elegant Chablis with a fresh palate and flinty minerality, softened with creamy fruit. A perfect balance of delicacy and power.
- 35 **Bourgogne Blanc Les S tilles, Olivier Leflaive, 2021** 79
Bright lemon in colour. The nose is pretty and fresh with notes of white flower. The palate shows citrus and apple notes, balanced with hints of creamy vanilla. The finish is long and lifted - a stunning wine from this superb producer.
- 50 **Mâcon-Verze, Domaine Leflaive, 2019** 98
The harvest is entirely manual, the pressing is done in Verze in buildings bought at the same time as the vines. The resulting wine is a wine of great prurity, both floral and mineral, which gives off an energy and liveliness.
- 38 **Montagny 1er Cru Bonneveaux, Olivier Leflaive, 2019** 110
Bright lemon in colour with flashes of green. Fresh stone fruits with hints of ginger on the nose. The wine has a great minerality balanced with plenty of concentrated, creamy fruit on the palate.
- 47 **Morey-Saint-Denis, Domaine Bruno Clair, 2015** 130
The stoniness of the terroir shines through the sun-kissed fruit of the vintage offering notes of ripe lemons, acacia, stone fruit, slate and crushed rocks. Harmonious and full-flavoured yet with sufficient tension and poise. A vineyard located just above Bonnes-Mares, En la Rue de Vergy is planted on poor, rocky limestone soils.
- 40 **Bourgogne Blanc, Domaine Leflaive, 2016** 135
From what is considered to be the greatest producer in Burgundy and probably by extension arguably the world's finest white producer, this is no ordinary Bourgogne Blanc, being declassified Puligny Montrachet from a couple of specific plots.
- 45 **Beaune Gr ves 1er Cru, Domaine Jacques Prieur, 2017** 145
Smooth and elegant with delicious spicy and anise notes. Generous and savoury with slightly mineral notes. Refreshing and embracing the palate on the finish with a touch of anise.
- 41 **Meursault Clos Cromin, Oliver Leflaive, 2019** 158
Pale yellow-gold, this presents a very pretty, gentle nose of warm brioche, nuts, delicate caramel and vanilla cream - a pastry shop attraction. The palate is similarly evocative, with equally appetising aromatics, though a fresh redeeming acidity avoids it being too hedonistic, with a very lovely finish.
- 43 **Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru, Domaine Francois Carillon, 2016** 160
An exceptional Chardonnay fashioned in a Puligny style, A powerful, forceful nose leads into a juicily-fruited palate of fleshy, joyous white fruit with cedar and zesty orange-rind. Concentrated and textural, "thanks" to the frost, which resulted in small berries.
- 42 **Puligny-Montrachet Les Meix, Oliver Leflaive, 2021** 170
Pale, shimmering gold, this is a delight. Lemon and apple pastries combine with delicate apricot notes, white flowers and crushed shell minerals on both the nose and palate, super - fresh and focused, with an attractive acidity, giving balance and direction - a lovely wine, beautifully handled.

- 26 **Muscadet sur lie, Jean François de Grand Mouton, JF Guilbaud, 2022, Loire** 42
The wine shows tangy pineapple, melon and jasmine aromas on the nose and a rich and stony, structured minerality on the palate with hints of white pepper and a refreshing spritz.
- 31 **Côtes-du-Rhône Blanc Les Becs Fins, Tardieu-Laurent, 2017, Rhône** 56
Shimmering gold and captivating, with floral notes, stone fruit and vanilla cream to the fore, with hints of warm brioche, macadamia nuts and pain aux raisins. The palate adds honey citrus and minerality..
- 33 **Gewürztraminer Beblenheim, Domaine Trapet, 2019, Alsace** 64
Pale lemon colour. Aromas of ripe peach, green citrus, nectarine and slaty minerality. The palate resonates with energy and pure, tangy lemon and lime fruit. Stony minerality adds definition and rigour.
- 37 **Pouilly-Fumé Les Origines, A&E Figeat, 2022, Loire** 64
With smoky greengage, grapefruit and nettle on the nose combined with zesty lime, yellow plum and elderflower on the palate, this wine is multi-layered and exceptionally elegant.
- 34 **Sancerre Domaine du Nozay 2021, Loire** 72
Pale lemon colour. Aromas of ripe peach, green citrus, nectarine and slaty minerality. The palate resonates with energy and pure, tangy lemon and lime fruit. Stony minerality adds definition and rigour.
- 64 **Jacquère, Apremont, Domaine de Chevillard, 2020, Savoie** 75
Alpine wine made with Jacquère grape, a fresh and rich white variety from Alps. Notes of peach and tropical fruit and a mouthfil and creamy character on the palate. Mathieu Goury, the young winemaker behind this project, believes in "old school" approach, organic farming and using a very limited quantity of sulphites.
- 29 **Pouilly-Fumé Silex, Domaine Didier Dagenau 2018, Loire** 210
Intense bouquet of flowers and resinous herbs, Impressive finish on the palate with citrus, grapefruit and floral notes. Complex wine with lots of minerality. This wine gets better with each sip.

ITALIAN WHITES

- 21 **Luna Pinot Grigio, Cecilia Beretta, 2022, Veneto** 38
Delicate and fresh with exceptional balance, this Pinot Grigio is leagues above the rest. The long ripening season creates a flavourful and expressive wine with zesty fruit and long lingering finish. Floral and almond notes, with ripe citrus fruit and a subtle minerality
- 30 **Etna Bianco, Tenuta delle Terre Nere, 2021, Sicily** 51
A fragrant and floral white, with good freshness and a delicious aromatic personality enriched by mineral notes.
- 20 **Passobianco Terre Siciliane IGT, Passopisciaro, 2018, Sicily** 79
Grown on the slopes of Mount Etna, this linear Chardonnay has subtle aromas of toasted nut, eucalyptus and white stone fruit. the racy palate offers yellow apple, roasted almond and lemon notes alongside firm acidity.

SPANISH WHITES

- 62 **A Pedreira, Albariño, Bodegas Fulcro, 2022 Rias Baixas** 55
Mineral, fresh and full of stone fruit flavours. Albariño with the typical "Atlantic" character.
- 24 **Veigadares Albariño, Adegas Galegas, 2020 Rias Baixas** 60
This lively and refreshing Albariño comes from its indigenous region of Rias Baixas in Galicia on Spain's rugged north west coast. Aged in some old oak, this wine has a degree of complexity rarely found in most Albariños.

23	Old Vines Chenin Blanc, 2021, Stellenbosch <i>Carefully selected grapes from old vine vineyards in the foothills of the Cape Fold mountains. Producing only very low yields, this fruit guarantees an intensity of fruit flavours. Warm peachy notes and almonds, layered with ripe pear and a pure acidity on the finish</i>	48
65	Rall White, Donovan Rall, 2021, Swartland <i>An infinitely complex nose with notes of dried flowers, pear, peach, citrus, apple, baking spice and white pepper. The palate is clean and focused, the acidity providing snap, the finish long and pithy. Precisely made but also somehow effortless, this combines great clarity of fruit with plenty of detail.</i>	66

ROSÉ WINES

11	Source Gabriel Rosé, 2022, Cotes de Provence, France <i>Chateau Tour de L'Eveque - This is classic Provence Rosé, from the highly regarded Regine Sumiere. So pale and delicate, yet fruity. Floral notes coupled with that kind of rich stone fruit that you only get from this part of France makes this elegant wine so very delicious.</i>	48
12	Sancerre Rosé, Domaine Tissier, Chameau Baland, 2021, Loire, France <i>From the more northerly climes of the Loire Valley, just over an hour's drive from Paris comes this delicate Pinot Noir based Rosé. Ripe and fully flavoured, yet refreshing with an underlying minerality.</i>	60

BURGUNDY

- 108 Auxey-Duresses Rouge, Thierry et Pascale Matrot, 2020** 92
A complex blend of aromatics comes through on the nose and palate, primary berries allied to more savoury fennel notes. The structure is more evidence here but all tannins are well integrated- lovely texture and a long, lightly peppered, perfumed finish.
- 109 Marsannay, Domaine Joseph Roty, 2018** 98
It is a must have for Burgundy lovers. Sweet, dark berry fruit in which you can feel the small berries and the high phenolic content of the vintage, alongside a supple approachability which allows this wine to be drinking early.
- 82 Cote de Nuits-Villages, Domaine Roty 2016** 100
Aromatic Burgundy with seducives floral petals aroma, cherry and a balance acidity. The Wine develops by the minute and opens up beautifully.
- 165 Savigny-les-Beaune, Domaine Francois Carillon, 2020** 110
François began working with his father Louis Carillon in 1988, but the domaine has been owned for 500 years by Carillon's family. Floral, red berries notes, earth and light spice aromas and flavors. Delicate and lacy, with a firm, chalky finish
- 166 Beaune 1er Cru Teurons, Domaine Rossignol Trapet, 2017** 132
Beautiful wine from Rossignol Trapet, biodynamic producers since 1997. Les Teurons is one of the most prestigious vineyards within Beaune 1er Cru. Delicate wild red berry fruit aromas with notes of forest floor. Medium-bodied with a refreshing acidity.
- 167 Gevrey Chambertin Clos des Meix des Ouches, Domaine des Varoilles, 2015** 145
This small parcel, just one hectare of 'village' wine, is a monopole. A wonderfully expressive nose of ripe raspberries and strawberries and spicy character, which comes from barrique ageing, 10% new oak. 2015 was a fantastic vintage and this Gevrey is superb!
- 144 Morey Saint-Denis Clos des Ormes, Louis Jadot, 2015** 150
Palate has a firm liquorice edge to sweet fruit. Powerfully ripe tannins and good acidity lengthen the finish for a lovely balance.
- 81 Beaune Rouge, Domaine Pierre Labet 2021** 160
Fine aromas of flowers, fruit and spices, hints of tea, Great finesse and round on the palate.
- 114 Cote de Nuits, Clos-Vougeot Grand Cru, Château De La Tour, 2013** 180
Ripe, rich and concentrated wine is full of jammy strawberry fruits that are deepened by the wood aging. The structure and the density of this wine show that it will age well
- 90 Nuits-St-Georges 1er Cru Clos des Forêts St-Georges, Domaine de L'Arlot, 2012** 190
Black cherries, tar, Licorice, smoke and menthol are some of the many notes that are woven together in this rich, deep wine. There is a baritone register to the fruit that is absolutely gorgeous. The powerful, structure finish completes this wonderful, now mature wine.
- 134 Nuits-Saint-Georges 1er Cru Clos Marechal, Domaine Jaques-Frederic Mugnier, 2010** 290
The bouquet of the 1er crus of Premeaux is remarkable and persistent, one finds the aroma of iris mingled with raspberries, even more so, that of white lilac
- 116 Chambolle Musigny, Comte Georges de Vogüé, 2014** 310
From probably the finest producer in Musigny, the 2014 Chambolle is drinking now, with its fragrant, voluminous bouquet of plush red cherries and a touch of Cassis. The palate is opulent and sweetly fruited on the entry, with fine tannins underpinning this classic wine.
- 80 Domaine de la Romanee-Conti, Cuvée Duvault Blochet, Vosne-Romanée Premier Cru, 2019** 1,500
For the seventh time since 1999, the domaine has released their Vosne-Romanée premier cru. Seductive and beautifully perfumed, this 1er Cru is a fabulous introduction to the Vosne-Romanée wines that form the core of this tasting. Soaring aromatics and silky contours give the 2019 its distinct air of sensuality. Dark-fleshed fruit, lavender and menthol are some of the notes that grace the exquisite 2019

BORDEAUX

- 91 Château La Courolle, Montagne St Émilion, 2020** 55
Plum ruby in colour, this has an inviting, accessible nose, rich in cherry and cassis, with delicate hints of vanilla. Fresh and upbeat, in line with the vintage, there is good fruit on the palate, nuances of dark chocolate and espresso coffee, all supported by firm, well-integrated tannins. A good food wine.
- 121 Ronan by Clinet, Château Clinet, 2018** 59
Named after Clinet's owner Ronan Laborde, this charming, fruit filled Merlot claret makes delicious drinking. Its grapes come from Castillon, Lussac and Bourg vineyards, gently handled by this prestigious team to produce this fine claret. The all-Merlot grapes are carefully selected from premium vineyards in Côtes de Castillon, Bourg and Lussac Saint Emilion.
- 118 Chateau Dutruch Grand Poujeaux, Cru Bourgeois, Moulis en Medoc, 2014** 64
Deep ruby-garnet, this presents a darkly fruited nose, earthy minerals, warm fruitcake and spice. There is a classical harmony here, intense old vine fruit complemented and held in check by wellrounded, firm tannins – good Sunday claret!
- 147 L'Aurage, Caroline et Louis Mitjavile, Castillon, Côtes de Bordeaux, 2017** 96
Like a St. Emilion! A great Bordeaux, smooth and crunchy, powerful and elegant, concentrate on fruity flavours and with cedar and oaky notes. Mainly Merlot grapes, at their best.
- 98 Château Roc de Cambes, Côtes de Bourg, 2013** 120
Freshly crushed blackcurrants and plums with an amazing range of aromas - not just the dark fruit but also orange, possibly even mango and lavender and garrigue. Super smooth, rich and explosive.
- 115 Château Rocheyron, St Émilion Grand Cru, 2012** 180
The 2012 vintage was characterised by a particularly hot, dry spring, early and rapid flowering, an unusually long summer lasting from April to September, and a magical late autumn, with warm, dry conditions. Great aromatic intensity on both nose and palate, redolent of fresh black berries, with elegant woody notes.
- 111 L'Espérance de Trotanoy, Chateau Trotanoy, Pomerol, 2016** 180
The second wine of the legendary Chateau Trotanoy and from the magnificent 2014 vintage. Black cherries and damp earth dominate the palate with hints of graphite and spice. Only 500 cases of this nectar produced.
- 117 Château Lynch Bages, 5eme Cru Classé, Pauillac, 2010** 255
Boldly scented with Crème de Cassis, blackberry and baked plums, chocolate box, incense and bay leaves. A firm grainy texture and a lively backbone lifts the core black fruit to a superb, juicy, ripe finish. A top wine in a top vintage!

REST OF FRANCE

- 149 Tradition, Cabardès, Famille Maurel, 2020, Languedoc-Roussillon 40**
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Grenache from the Mediterranean coast. Jammy aromas of cherry and raspberry with a hint of herbal notes. Medium body wine, very versatile with a lot of dishes.
- 124 Monte Nero, Cotes de Roussillon, Domaine Boucabeille, 2017, Languedoc-Roussillon 49**
Brilliant garnet colour. Enchanting nose of spices and cocoa with hints of garrigue. Roundness and liveliness on the palate with notes of ripe cherry and fig with a pleasant touch of acidity on the finish which brings a lot of freshness
- 123 Arraditz Béarn Rouge, Cave de Gan, 2017, South West 56**
A rich fruit forward wine, formed around a bold tannic structure. Grown across vineyards in the Béarn, from vines over 25 years old and aged for 18-months before bottling. Crushed raspberry and spice supported by a powerful tannic structure.
- 96 Moulin-a-Vent Coeur de Terroir Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Labruyère, 2018, Beaujolais 65**
A saturated ruby colour, followed by a beautiful pure red berry nose, dense and inviting. The palate is veritably singing, so ripe and supple, with resounding raspberry fruit. Darts of dark ferrous minerality and a seam of brininess from the mid-palate through to the finish.
- 101 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Grande Reserve, Chateau Beauchêne, 2021, Rhône 85**
This is a wonderful example from this small yet excellent estate. Rich, dark and handsome! This full bodied and concentrated red exudes more-ish flavours of baked plum and damson fruit, kirsch and sweet spice.
- 83 Lafarge Vial Fleure, Clos Vernay 2020 95**
Nose of ripe plums, pepper and a slight earthiness, Firm Tannins and a good long finish,
- 119 Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge, Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe, 2006, Rhône 125**
A deep brooding and tightly knit wine, concentrated and rich with classic herb and garrigue characters which add further complexity. The structure is firm and the tannins are deliciously ripe. A beautiful and complex Châteauneuf from an outstanding vintage.

ITALIAN REDS

- 87 Valpolicella Classico Superiore Ripasso "Torre del Falasco", Cantina della Valpantena, 2019, Veneto 48**
A delicious example of Ripasso from one of the best area of the region. Deep ruby red, with fine bitter cherry fruit, soft and ripe with a nice bite of acidity on the end and a spicy character.
- 95 Chianti Classico Terre di Prenzano, Vignamaggio, 2020, Tuscany 58**
Chianti at its most refined, with traditional flavours of sour cherry, dried herbs and mocha, supported by fine tannins. This wine is concentrated, yet restrained.
- 100 Amarone Classico della Valpolicella, Viviani, 2018, Veneto 90**
Spicy, dark cherry and mocha with fresh, wild berry notes and a long, sophisticated finish.
- 155 Sgarzon, Vigneti dell Dolomiti, Foradori, 2021, Trentino, Italy 93**
A rich and elegant red from the Dolomites. Teroldego is one of the indigenous grapes of Trentino region. Elisabetta Foradori, who contributed to rise the quality of the family winery, was one of the first biodynamic producer in the region.
- 104 Barolo La Tartufaia, Giulia Negri, 2019, Piedmont 102**
This La Tartufaia is really attractive deep garnet in colour. It offers a mature nose, savoury notes allied to liqueur macerated dried fruit compote, perfumed and spicy. The palate is silken, mocha-rich, with earthy dark chocolate and espresso notes, layered with black cherry and cream- all underscored by mineral precision and refreshed by rose and violet.

- 146 **Spatbugunder, A Christmann, 2018, Pfalz** 62
Elegant Pinot Noir from Germany, aged in oak barrel, which it gives spicy aromas and great structure. Family project, practising biodynamic viticulture.

AUSTRIAN REDS

- 156 **Dorfkultur Rot, Schuster, 2019, Burgenland** 80
Blaufränkisch is the Austrian indigenous the grape of this powerful red wine. Intense flavour of dark fruit and forest notes. Firm tannins and grate structure. A family project started in 1970 by Rosi Schuster and took over form her son in 2007, who started to farm the vineyards completely organic.

SPANISH REDS

This opulent Rioja Reserva is made by a small family winery, Bodegas Zugober, in the Rioja Alavesa area. While respecting traditional structure, the wine is bursting with ripe, dark fruit balanced by complex savoury notes of leather and tobacco.
- 163 **Viña Bosconia Rioja Reserva, R. López de Heredia, 2012, Rioja** 75
Possibly one of the best "classics" in Rioja region. Complexity and a great freshness, despite the long ageing.

- 148 **Aalto, Aalto Bodegas y Viñedos, 2020, Ribera del Duero** 94
Aalto is one of the most premium winery in Ribera del Duero. This wine displays all the character of the big reds from the region, with an incredible finesse. Very old bush vines from the coldest part of the region give every year perfect ripened grapes and made a wine with intense black cherry and plum aroma, powerful on the palate, with a long vanilla and buttery finish.
- 162 **Flor De Pingus, Dominio de Pingus, 2014, Ribera del Duero** 195
Possibly one of the best expression of the region. Outstanding quality, elegant and complex, powerful and silken on the palate. 2014 was a cool vintage and gave freshness and longevity to the wines. This is a real masterpiece from Peter Sisseck, a truly gem!

- 133 Tokaji 5 Puttonyos Royal Tokaji 2017, Tokaji, Hungary 50cl 70ml glass - £15 95**
This fabulous wine, once the favourite at the Tsarist Court in St Petersburg, is once again gaining great plaudits. Dried honey, wax resin and a good dollop of marmalade dominate the nutty, quince laden palate.

This wine doesn't need presentation. Owned since 1984 by Château Lafite-Rothschild, it is one of the best expression of Sauternes. Rich notes of apricot jam and sweet spices as saffron. Concentrated dried fruit flavours on the palate.
